**January 15th and February 12th**

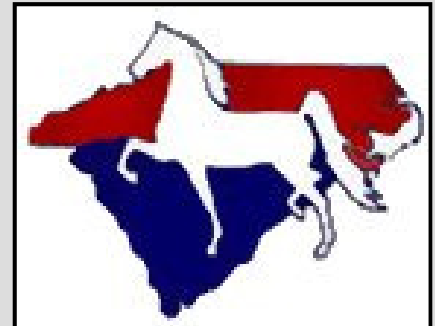
**11:00 a.m.**

January 15th Winter Tournament sign ups are now available in the lounge! The cost is \$225 which includes 2 classes. Family members will receive \$25 off per additional rider.

Winter Tournaments are formatted very similar to Academy Shows with classes open to all age groups in Walk and Trot and Walk, Trot, & Canter. They are terrific starter shows for new riders who wish to compete with our Academy Team, as well as a great practice for experienced academy and show riders. The only difference is that the attire is more casual. Riders wear jods (riding pants), boots, gloves, helmets, Lenux vests, and any color shirt. Lenux vests are now available in the Lenux store! If you sign up for this tournament but do not show-there is a \$50 no show fee.

## American Saddlebred Association of the Carolinas

ALL members, please fill out your 2011 memberships prior to the convention in January. Along with your memberships, please fill out and send in your high point nominations for 2011- horse and rider! If you want to earn points for the 2011 show season, you must send in your membership forms and nominations prior to the start of the 2011 show season.



**What is ASAC?** The American Saddlebred Association of the Carolina's. It is the United Professional Horseman's Association's governing body for the Carolina Horse Show Circuit.

**Should I join?** YES! Membership is very cheap (\$5 youth/\$10 adult.) If you or your child is interested in participating in 2011 horse shows, we strongly recommend that you become an ASAC member so the rider's points are recorded. Along with a membership- you will turn in a nomination form for your rider or horse's division for 2011. Members (who turn in nomination forms) earn points at every horse show in 2011. End of Year High Points are awarded in January at the annual convention, held at the Embassy Suites in Concord. Members come from all over North and South Carolina- consisting of performance and academy riders of American Saddlebred Horses. Points are tabulated by rating of show (based on size and length of show) and your placement in the class. Members also receive the ASAC newsletter and directory.
